

## **EFI Standards 5.5 (2007)**

## **Definition High-resolution**

High resolution typing is defined as identifying HLA alleles at the resolution level of 4 digits or more.

at least resolving all ambiguities resulting from polymorphisms located within

HLA class I: Exon 2 and Exon 3

HLA class II: Exon 2

and resolving all ambiguities that encompass a null allele,

wherever the polymorphism is located

unless it can be demonstrated that an expressed antigen is present on the cells.
